- 1. Who was Jesus according to His generation? Mark 3:20-22
 - a. The multitudes thought him **<u>divine</u>** (verse 20
 - b. His own people thought him **<u>deranged</u>** (verse 21
 - c. The religious establishment thought him **demonic** (verse 22)
 - i. He is **possessed** of a demon Beelzebub the Lord of flies.
 - ii. He is **serving** the devil - by the ruler of demons...
- 2. Who is Jesus to this generation? Mark 3:23-30
 - a. Jesus is the answer to Satan's **supplanters**
 - i. Satan will not fight himself (Verse 24)
 - ii. Satan will not **<u>divide</u>** his kingdom (verse 25-26)
 - b. Jesus is the answer to Satan's **strongholds**. Verse 27
 - c. Jesus is the answer to sin's **<u>strangleholds</u>**. (verse 28)
 - d. Jesus sounds the alarm to Satan's **strategy** verse 29-30
 - i. All sin can be forgiven!
 - ii. One sin will never be forgiven.
 - The specific sin in Jesus day was the <u>blasphemy of</u> <u>the Holy Spirit.</u>
 - The specific sin today is only one: <u>rejection</u> of the spirit's work!
