Peter's Pentecost Sermon (Acts 2:14-37) Part I & Part II

Disciples proclaimed the 'mighty works of God' in the tongue of the people Peter stands up & tells the crowds the disciples are not drunk as some say Peter's first sermon explains what they see, he refers to Joel 2:28-32; Ps 16 Peter declares that Pentecost means Holy Spirit has come through Jesus

I. Peter's Quotation of Joel and the Holy Scriptures' Unity (2:16-21)

All the servants of God will declare the mighty works of God in Jesus

II. Peter's Conviction: God's Sovereign Control over History (2:21,23)

Jesus was crucified by men, but God's sovereign hand was directing it all

III. Peter's Passionate Conviction about Who Jesus Christ Is (2:22-36)

- (i) His Life (2:22)
- (ii) His Death (2:23)
- (iii) His Resurrection (2:24-32)
 - a. All Scripture bears witness to Christ
 - b. Disciples taught this with reference to David & his royal seed
 - c. Peter's use of Ps 16 is consistent with God's promise to David
- (iv) His Exaltation (2:33-36)

IV. The People are Convicted about the Need for Salvation (2:37-39)

Repent, believe, be baptized: promise of salvation: for all who will believe

Conclusion: A Conviction about Urgency

Peter changes Joel's words from afterward- "last days:" flee from judgment
