## I. POWER OF WORDS PRODUCES INFLUENCE (3:1-12)

**A.** Our tongue has the power to direct like a bit or rudder (3:1-4).

"The lips of the righteous feed many, But fools die for lack of wisdom." Proverbs 10:21

"17 Incline your ear and hear the words of the wise, And apply your heart to my knowledge;

18 For it is a pleasant thing if you keep them within you; Let them all be fixed upon your lips,"

Proverbs 22:17-18

**B.** Our tongue has the power to destroy like a fire or animal (3:5-8).

"20 Where there is no wood, the fire goes out; And where there is no talebearer, strife ceases.

21 As charcoal is to burning coals, and wood to fire, So is a contentious man to kindle strife."

Proverbs 26:20-21

"27 An ungodly man digs up evil, And it is on his lips like a burning fire.

28 A perverse man sows strife, And a whisperer separates the best of friends." Proverbs 16:27-28

C. Our tongue has the power to delight like a fountain or tree (3:9-12).

"Anxiety in the heart of man causes depression, But a good word makes it glad." Proverbs 12:25

"A wholesome tongue is a tree of life, But perverseness in it breaks the spirit." Proverbs 15:4

## II. POWER OF WORDS PRODUCES INIQUITY (3:6-8)

**A.** Many sins are linked to the tongue (v6).

"16 These six things the LORD hates, Yes, seven are an abomination to Him:

17 A proud look, A lying tongue, Hands that shed innocent blood.

18 A heart that devises wicked plans, Feet that are swift in running to evil,

19 A false witness who speaks lies, And one who sows discord among brethren." Proverbs 6:16-19

**B.** You cannot control your tongue (vs 7-8).

"Pride goes before destruction, And a haughty spirit before a fall." Proverbs 16:18

# III. POWER OF WORDS PRODUCES INCONSISTENCY (3:9-12)

A. It is a battle between the Spirit and the flesh (vs 9-10a).

"16 I say then: Walk in the Spirit, and you shall not fulfill the lust of the flesh.

17 For the flesh lusts against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh; and these are contrary to one another, so that you do not do the things that you wish." Galatians 5:16-17

**B.** The goal is consistent obedience with your tongue (vs 10b-12).

"Keep your tongue from evil, And your lips from speaking deceit." Psalm 34:13
