Introduction:

Matthew 7:14-15

National Survey:

- 16% said they did not believe in an afterlife
- 13% said that hell was just a symbol of an unknown bad outcome after death
- 68% said that they did not believe that hell was a place is literal fire as described in the Bible

Hell in the Bible is described by a number of different terms:

- It is found to be described as literal fire as found in Matthew 5:22, & 18:9
- Everlasting fire in Matthew 18:8, & 25:41
- Fire unquenchable in Luke 3:17
- Eternal fire in Jude 7
- A furnace of fire in Matthew 13:42, 50
- Fire & brimstone in the book of Revelation.

2 Peter 3:9-10

- Hell is also known as darkness.
 - “Outer Darkness” Matthew 8:12
 - The “Blackness of Darkness” Jude 1:13
 - “Chains of darkness” 2 Peter 2:4
- Hell is also known as a prison.
 - Revelation 1:18

- Hell is also known for the sound.
 - Matthew 13:41-42

Context: “There is no peace for the wicked,” says the LORD.” Isaiah 48:22

Much of the Old Testament deals with false prophets & the horrible fate they suffer at the hands of God.

- Jeremiah 23:14-20
