**I. The **Submissive** Aspect  
of Our Duty v. 1-5**



### **Romans 13:1 (TEV)**

<sup>1</sup> Everyone must obey state authorities, because no authority exists without God's permission, and the existing authorities have been put there by God.

### **Romans 13:1 (KJV)**

<sup>1</sup> Let every soul be subject unto the higher powers. For there is no power but of God: the powers that be are ordained of God.

### **Romans 13:2 (TEV)**

<sup>2</sup> Whoever opposes the existing authority opposes what God has ordered; and anyone who does so will bring judgment on himself.

### **Romans 13:2 (KJV)**

<sup>2</sup> Whosoever therefore resisteth the power, resisteth the ordinance of God: and they that resist



### **Romans 13:3 (TEV)**

<sup>3</sup> For rulers are not to be feared by those who do good, but by those who do evil. Would you like to be unafraid of those in authority? Then do what is good, and they will praise you,

### **Romans 13:3 (KJV)**

<sup>3</sup> For rulers are not a terror to good works, but to the evil. Wilt thou then not be afraid of the power? do that which is good, and thou shalt have praise of the same:

### **Romans 13:4 (TEV)**

<sup>4</sup> because they are God's servants working for your own good. But if you do evil, then be afraid of them, because their power to punish is real. They are God's servants and carry out God's punishment on those who do evil.

### **Romans 13:4 (KJV)**

<sup>4</sup> For he is the minister of God to thee for good. But if thou do that which is evil, be afraid; for he beareth not the sword in vain: for he is the minister of God, a revenger to execute wrath upon him that doeth evil.

### **Romans 13:5 (TEV)**

<sup>5</sup> For this reason you must obey the authorities —not just because of God's punishment, but also as a matter of conscience.

### **Romans 13:5 (KJV)**

<sup>5</sup> Wherefore ye must needs be subject, not only for wrath, but also for conscience sake.

### **Romans 13:6 (TEV)**

<sup>6</sup> That is also why you pay taxes, because the authorities are working for God when they fulfill their duties.

### **Romans 13:6 (KJV)**

<sup>6</sup> For this cause pay ye tribute also: for they are God's ministers, attending continually upon this very thing.



### **Romans 13:7 (TEV)**

<sup>7</sup> Pay, then, what you owe them; pay them your personal and property taxes, and show respect and honor for them all.

### **Romans 13:7 (KJV)**

<sup>7</sup> Render therefore to all their dues: tribute to whom tribute *is due*; custom to whom custom; fear to whom fear; honour to whom honour.

<sup>8</sup> Be under obligation to no one—the only obligation you have is to love one another. Whoever does this has obeyed the Law.

### **Romans 13:8 (KJV)**

<sup>8</sup> Owe no man any thing, but to love one another: for he that loveth another hath fulfilled the law.

### **Romans 13:9 (TEV)**

<sup>9</sup> The commandments, "Do not commit adultery; do not commit murder; do not steal; do not desire what belongs to someone else"—all these, and any others besides, are summed up in the one command, "Love your neighbor as you love yourself."

### **Romans 13:9 (KJV)**

<sup>9</sup> For this, Thou shalt not commit adultery, Thou shalt not kill, Thou shalt not steal, Thou shalt not bear false witness, Thou shalt not covet; and if *there be* any other commandment, it is briefly comprehended in this saying, namely, Thou shalt love thyneighbour as thyself.

### **Romans 13:10 (TEV)**

<sup>10</sup> If you love others, you will never do them wrong; to love, then, is to obey the whole Law.

### **Romans 13:10 (KJV)**

<sup>10</sup> Love worketh no ill to his neighbour: therefore love *is* the fulfilling of the law.
