
## **Bottom Line:**

All of creation is feeling the negative impact of mankind's rebellion against God, but God's glory is still visible and will become fully manifest when He returns!

1. All of creation has been negatively impacted by our \_\_\_\_\_ against God! Romans 8:18-22

A. Creation groans but still reveals the \_\_\_\_\_\_ of God. Romans 1:20

should occur with regularity if evolution has any hope of being true.


