 - b. General **Indifference** Php 2:21
 - c. Masked **Insincerity** Matt 5:14
 - d. Cultural **Inattention** –Eph 5: <u>15</u>
 - e. Self-**Indulgence** –Eph chapter 5

So why was Daniel so credible?

- Daniel showed **<u>stability</u>** in the crisis. (verse 14)
- Daniels sought to <u>save</u> his competitors (verse 24)
- Daniel worked to serve his <u>authority</u> (verse 16)
- Daniel decided to <u>share</u> his blessings (verse 49)
