HOW GOD BRINGS HIS ELECT PEOPLE IN - Outline

Text: "Thou shalt call his name JESUS: for he shall save his people from their sins" Matthew 1:21. Also read Psalm 107, verses 1 thru 8. Notice that it is the work of God alone, as He brings His chosen people into the fold.

- I. AWAKENING See Psalm 119:59 and Luke 15:11-24.
 - 1. God awakens us to our LOST condition.
 - 2. God awakens us to the Great Judgment Day.
 - 3. God awakens us to the CERTAINTY of Hell.
 - 4. God awakens us to our HELPLESS condition.
 - 5. God awakens us to the danger of the unpardonable sin (Mat. 12:31-37).

II. WITHERING.

- 1. God withers us with His Holy Law (Exodus 20).
- 2. God withers us by mercy.
- 3. God withers us by grace.
- 4. God withers us with Providence.
- 5. God withers us with the Holy Ghost (Isa. 40:6-9).

III. QUICKENING – See John 5:21.

- 1. Regenerates
- 2. Makes alive
- 3. Gives spiritual life (Eph. 2:1-10).

IV. DRAWING – Notice John 6:44-45.

- 1. Blessed, sweet work as the Holy Ghost draws us to the Saviour.
- 2. Holy Ghost leads us to Christ.
- 3. Holy Ghost wins us to Christ.
- 4. Holy Ghost loves us to Christ.
- 5. Holy Ghost attracts us to Christ.

V. GRANTING OF REPENTANCE – Notice Acts 5:29-33; 11:18.

- 1. Repentance is a change of mind.
- 2. Repentance is a change of masters.
- 3. Repentance is a change of manners, of lifestyle.
- 4. Repentance is a change of mission.
- 5. Repentance involves a change of motives (Gal. 1:23; Acts 9:15).

VI. CREATING OF FAITH – See Eph. 2:8-10; Acts 18:27.

This saving, God-given faith is —

- 1. A receiving faith
- 2. A believing faith
- 3. An acting faith
- 4. An obedient faith
- 5. A faith that commits its all to Christ (2 Tim. 1:12; Heb. 6:1-9)

VII. GIVING OF A NEW HEART – Read Ezek. 36:26-31.

- 1. A NEW heart, not the natural deceitful heart (Jer. 17:9)
- 2. A NEW spirit
- 3. A NEW mind
- 4. A NEW will (Psa. 110:3)
- 5. NEW power, an altogether new creation (2 Cor. 5:17)

VIII. LIFTING OF THE WHITE FLAG OF PEACE IN THE SOUL.

- 1. This is a peace of God that cannot be destroyed.
- 2. A peace that cannot be seriously disturbed (Rom. 5:1-2; 10:13-15).

IX. IN THE NINTH PLACE, NOTICE THE HOLY GHOST TAKING OVER – As in Act 2:1-4 and Num. 11:25). Notice the Spirit of God does not come to merely take sides but to take over! He takes over as your —

- 1. Guide
- 2. Guest
- 3. Guard
- 4. Teacher
- 5. Sanctifier

Conclusion:

Notice that Christ is our Sanctification, and the Holy Spirit is our Sanctifier. 1 Cor. 1:30-31; Rom. 15:16; 1 Thes. 4:3-8. Sanctified, preserved and called — that is the story of God's people as He brings them in — Jude vs. 1. Amen and Amen.
