WHAT GOD THINKS ABOUT YOU AND YOUR WORK

I. WORK TO SERVE GOD

A. God is a worker and He created you in His worker image.

"In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth."

Genesis 1:1

"And on the seventh day God ended His work which He had done, and He rested on the seventh day from all His work which He had done." Genesis 2:2

"Is this not the carpenter, the Son of Mary, and brother of James, Joses, Judas, and Simon? And are not His sisters here with us?" So they were offended at Him." Mark 6:3

"27 So God created man in His own image; in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them. 28 Then God blessed them, and God said to them, "Be fruitful and multiply; fill the earth and subdue it; have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over every living thing that moves on the earth."

"9 Six days you shall labor and do all your work, 10 but the seventh day is the Sabbath of the LORD your God...."

- **B.** Is Work The Result Of The Curse For Sin? (See Genesis 3:17-19)
 - Work was given before the fall, not after it.

"8: And the LORD God planted a garden eastward in Eden; and there he put the man whom he had formed." 15: And the LORD God took the man, and put him into the garden of Eden to dress it and to keep it."

Genesis 2:8, 15

• God cursed the ground which did make the work environment more difficult, but He did not curse the work itself.

"For we know that the whole creation groaneth and travaileth in pain together until now." Romans 8:22

• Work is not a curse from God, but instead work is a gift from God.

"And also that every man should eat and drink, and enjoy the good of all his labour, it is the gift of God."

Ecclesiastes 3:13

II. WORK TO MEET NEEDS

A. You work to meet your own needs.

"10 For even when we were with you, we commanded you this: If anyone will not work, neither shall he eat.

11 For we hear that there are some who walk among you in a disorderly manner, not working at all, but are busybodies. 12 Now those who are such we command and exhort through our Lord Jesus Christ that they work in quietness and eat their own bread.

13 But as for you, brethren, do not grow weary in doing good.

14 And if anyone does not obey our word in this epistle, note that person and do not keep company with him, that he may be ashamed.

15 Yet do not count him as an enemy, but admonish him as a brother." II Thessalonians 3:10-15

B. You work to meet your family's needs.

"But if any provide not for his own, and specially for those of his own house, he hath denied the faith, and is worse than an infidel."

I Timothy 5:8

C, You work to meet your neighbors needs.

"34 Yes, you yourselves know that these hands have provided for my necessities, and for those who were with me.

35 I have shown you in every way, by laboring like this, that you must support the weak. And remember the words of the Lord Jesus, that He said, 'It is more blessed to give than to receive.'"

Acts 20:34-35
