The Word's Words of Eternal Life

I. Jesus is the 'Word'

- Joh 1:1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.
- 1Jn 5:7 For there are three that bear record in heaven, the Father, the Word, and the Holy Ghost: and these three are one.

II. The Word had the words that could stop all words

- Joh 7:46 The officers answered, **Never man spake like this man**.
- Luk 14:5 ... Which of you shall have an ass or an ox fallen into a pit, and will not straightway pull him out on the sabbath day?
- Luk 14:6 And they could not answer him again to these things.
- Mat 21:25 The baptism of John, whence was it? from heaven, or of men? ...
- Mat 21:27 And they answered Jesus, and said, We cannot tell...
- Luk 7:43 Simon answered and said, I suppose...
- Joh 8:7 ...**He that is without sin** among you, let him first cast a stone at her...
- Joh 8:9 And they which heard *it*, being convicted by *their own* conscience, **went out one** by **one**, beginning at the eldest, *even* unto the last...
- Luk 20:25 And he said unto them, Render therefore unto Caesar the things which be Caesar's, and unto God the things which be God's.
- Luk 20:26 And they could not take hold of his words before the people: and they marvelled at his answer, and held their peace.

- III. Whether commanding or preaching—The Word's words had great power
- Luk 4:32 And they were astonished at his doctrine: for his word was with power.
- Luk 2:47 And all that heard him were astonished at his understanding and answers.
- Mat 8:8 The centurion answered and said, Lord, I am not worthy that thou shouldest come under my roof: but **speak the word only**, and my servant shall be healed.
- Mat 8:16 When the even was come, they brought unto him many that were possessed with devils: and he cast out the spirits **with** *his* **word**, and healed all that were sick:
- Mar 1:22 And they were astonished at his doctrine: for he **taught them as one that had authority**, and not as the scribes.
- Mar 1:23 And there was in their synagogue a man with an unclean spirit; and he cried out,
- Mar 1:24 Saying, Let *us* alone; what have we to do with thee, thou Jesus of Nazareth? art thou come to destroy us? I know thee who thou art, the Holy One of God.
- Mar 1:25 And Jesus rebuked him, saying, **Hold thy peace**, and come out of him.
- Mar 1:26 And when the unclean spirit had torn him, and cried with a loud voice, he came out of him.
- Mar 1:27 And they were all amazed, insomuch that they questioned among themselves, saying, What thing is this? what new doctrine *is* this? for **with authority commandeth he even the unclean spirits**, and they do obey him.
- Mat 7:28 And it came to pass, when Jesus had ended these sayings, the people were astonished at his doctrine:
- Mat 7:29 For **he taught them as** *one* **having authority**, and not as the scribes.
- Luk 4:17 And there was delivered unto him the book of the prophet Esaias. And when he had opened the book, he found the place where it was written,
- Luk 4:18 The Spirit of the Lord *is* upon me, because he hath anointed me to **preach the gospel to the poor**; he hath sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised...
- Luk 4:22 And all bare him witness, and wondered at the gracious words which proceeded out of his mouth. And they said, Is not this Joseph's son?
- Luk 24:25 ...O fools, and slow of heart to believe all that the prophets have spoken:
- Luk 24:26 Ought not Christ to have suffered these things, and to enter into his glory?
- Luk 24:27 And beginning at Moses and all the prophets, he expounded unto them in all the scriptures the things concerning himself.
- Luk 24:30 And it came to pass, as he sat at meat with them, he took bread, and blessed *it*, and brake, and gave to them...
- Luk 24:31 And their eyes were opened, and they knew him; and he vanished out of their sight.
- Luk 24:32 And they said one to another, **Did not our heart burn within us, while he talked with us** by the way, and while he opened to us the scriptures?

- Joh 8:30 As **he spake these words**, many believed on him.
- Joh 8:31 Then said Jesus to those Jews which believed on him, If ye **continue in my word**, *then* are ye my disciples indeed;
- Joh 8:32 And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free.

IV. The Word has the words of eternal life

- Joh 6:66 From that *time* many of his disciples went back, and walked no more with him.
- Joh 6:67 Then said Jesus unto the twelve, Will ye also go away?
- Joh 6:68 Then Simon Peter answered him, Lord, to whom shall we go? thou hast the words of eternal life.
- Joh 6:69 And we believe and are sure that thou art that Christ, the Son of the living God.

V. The Word has the words that give eternal life

- Joh 5:25 Verily, verily, I say unto you, The hour is coming, and now is, when the dead shall hear **the voice of the Son of God**: and they that hear shall live.
- Joh 5:26 For as the Father hath life in himself; so hath he given to the Son to have life in himself:
- Joh 5:27 And hath given him authority to execute judgment also, because he is the Son of man.
- Joh 5:28-29 Marvel not at this: for the hour is coming, in the which all that are in the graves shall hear his voice, And shall come forth...
- Joh 1:4 In him was **life...**
- Joh 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the **life**: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.
- Joh 14:19 ...because I live, ye shall live also.
- Joh 17:2 As thou hast given him power over all flesh, that he should **give eternal life** to as many as thou hast given him.
- Joh 11:25 Jesus said unto her, I am the resurrection, and the **life**: he that believeth in me, though he were dead, yet shall he live:
- Joh 11:26 And whosoever liveth and believeth in me shall never die. Believest thou this?

VI. The Word has the words that explain how we don't and do get eternal life

- Joh 5:40 And ye will not come to me, that ye might have life.
- Joh 6:44 No man can come to me, except the Father which hath sent me draw him: and I will raise him up at the last day.
- Joh 6:45 It is written in the prophets, And they shall be all taught of God. Every man therefore that hath heard, and hath learned of the Father, cometh unto me.
- Joh 6:37 All that the Father giveth me shall come to me; and him that cometh to me I will in no wise cast out.

- Joh 6:38 For I came down from heaven, not to do mine own will, but the will of him that sent me.
- Joh 6:39 And this is the Father's will which hath sent me, that of all which he hath given me I should lose nothing, but should raise it up again at the last day.
- Joh 6:63 It is the spirit that quickeneth; the flesh profiteth nothing: the words that I speak unto you, *they* are spirit, and *they* are life.
- Joh 6:64 But there are some of you that believe not. For Jesus knew from the beginning who they were that believed not, and who should betray him.
- Joh 6:65 And he said, Therefore said I unto you, that no man can come unto me, except it were given unto him of my Father.
- Joh 3:3 Jesus answered and said unto him, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God.
- Joh 3:4 Nicodemus saith unto him, How can a man be born when he is old? can he enter the second time into his mother's womb, and be born?
- Joh 3:5 Jesus answered, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born of water and *of* the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God.
- Joh 3:6 That which is born of the flesh is flesh; and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit.
- Joh 3:7 Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again.
- Joh 3:8 The wind bloweth where it listeth, and thou hearest the sound thereof, but canst not tell whence it cometh, and whither it goeth: so is every one that is born of the Spirit.

VII. The Word has the words that make us sure we will have eternal life

- Joh 10:11 I am the good shepherd: the good shepherd giveth his life for the sheep.
- Joh 10:14 I am the good shepherd, and know my *sheep*, and am known of mine.
- Joh 10:15 As the Father knoweth me, even so know I the Father: and I lay down my life for the sheep.
- Joh 10:16 And other sheep I have, which are not of this fold: them also I must bring, and they shall hear my voice; and there shall be one fold, *and* one shepherd.
- Joh 10:24 Then came the Jews round about him, and said unto him, How long dost thou make us to doubt? If thou be the Christ, tell us plainly.
- Joh 10:25 Jesus answered them, I told you, and ye believed not: the works that I do in my Father's name, they bear witness of me.
- Joh 10:26 But ye believe not, because ye are not of my sheep, as I said unto you.
- Joh 10:27 My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me:
- Joh 10:28 And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any *man* pluck them out of my hand.
- Joh 10:29 My Father, which gave *them* me, is greater than all; and no *man* is able to pluck *them* out of my Father's hand.
- Joh 10:30 I and my Father are one.
