

THE JUDGMENT OF THE BELIEVER'S SIN

When the Scriptures are searched, it becomes apparent that there are three judgments directly related to the Believer or follower of Christ Jesus. The first judgment deals with the believer as a **SINNER**: the second judgment deals with the believer as a **SON**: and the third judgment deals with the believer as a **SERVANT**. Our study will allow us to examine all three judgments.

1. **SUBJECTS**: believers as to their sin.
NOTE: 1 John 2:2 Jesus died potentially for all men's sin but only actually for the sinner who trusts Christ as Savior
2. **PLACE OF JUDGMENT**: Calvary, Golgotha, Place of the skull
3. **BASIS OF THE JUDGMENT**:
 - a. John 19:30 'teltelasti' = paid in full, completed
 - b. Hebrews 9:24-28; Hebrews 10:9-14; Hebrews 9:11-14: once and for all never to be repeated event: satisfied the holiness of a holy God and meet the needs of depraved humanity
4. **RESULT OF THE JUDGMENT**:
 - a. Death to Christ:
Isaiah 53:6; 2 Corinthians 5:21; 1 Peter 2:21-24; Romans 6:23;
Romans 5:6-11; Colossians 2:13-15; Romans 3:23-26; 1 John 1:7
 - b. Justification to the believer:
Romans 10:4; John 3:16; Romans 8:1-3; John 5:24
5. **TIME OF THIS JUDGMENT**: the past
6. **COMPLETED**: there will be no future judgment of the believer for his sins as crimes against God, for they have been already judged at the Cross of Calvary and in man's substitution, Jesus Christ of Nazareth. Even our present day courts of law understand the principle of double jeopardy. Once and for all, sin has been thoroughly dealt with.
