## God in the Garden

Genesis 3:1-13, 22-24

- I. SIN: "she took from its fruit and ate" (vv.1-7)
  - **A. Deception:** "You surely shall not die!" (vv.1-5)
  - **B. Disobedience:** "she gave also to her husband" (vv.6-7)
- II. <u>SECLUSION</u>: "they...hid themselves" (vv.8-13)
  - **A.** Escape: "God called...'Where are you?'" (vv.8-11)
    - 1. Avoidance: "hid...from the presence of the LORD" (vv.8-9)
    - 2. Apprehension: "afraid because I was naked" (vv.10-11)
  - **B. Excuses:** "The woman...The serpent..." (vv.12-13)
    - 1. Adam: "The woman...gave me...and I ate" (v.12)
    - 2. Eve: "The serpent deceived me...and I ate" (v.13)
- III. SEPARATION: "He drove the man out" (vv.22-24)
  - **A. Expelled:** "out of the garden" (vv.22-23)
    - 1. Perverted: "the man has become like one of us" (v.22a)
    - 2. Protected: "lest he...live forever" (vv.22b-23)
  - **B. Excluded:** "to guard the way" (v.24)
    - 1. Guard: "He stationed a cherubim" (v.24a)
    - 2. Goad: "He stationed...the flaming sword" (v.24b)
