to be a light of the Gentiles, that
thou shouldst be for salvation unto
the ends of the earth.
48 And when the Gentiles heard
this, they were glad, and glorified
the word of the Lord: and as many
as were ordained to eternal life
believed. / Chro 17:9 Prepared
49 And the word of the Lord was
published throughout all the region.

Opposition from devout and
honourable women, and chief
citizens. (Cf. vs. 6, 45.) (Zeal)
50 But the Jews stirred up the de-
vout and honourable (women), and
the chief men of the city, and raised
persecution against Paul and Bar-
nabas, and expelled them out of their
coasts.
51 But they shook off the dust of
their feet against them, and came
unto Iconium.
52 And the disciples were filled
with joy, and with the Holy Ghost.

CHAPTER 14.

The work in Iconium.

AND it came to pass in Iconium,
that they went both together
into the synagogue of the Jews,
and so spake, that a great multitude
both of the Jews and also of the
Greeks believed. (Saved)
2 But the unbelieving Jews
stirred up the Gentiles, and made
their minds evil affected against the
brethren. 1713
3 Long time therefore abode they
(speaking boldly) in the Lord, which
gave testimony unto the word of
his grace, and granted signs and
wonders to be done by their hands.
4 But the multitude of the city
was divided: and part held with
the Jews, and part with the apos-
tles. 1st time Paul & Barnabas
5 And when there was an assault
made both of the Gentiles, and also
of the Jews with their rulers, to use
them despitefully, and to stone
them,

6 They were ware of it, and fled
unto Lystra and Derbe, cities of
Lycaonia, and unto the region that
lieth round about:
7 And there they preached the
gospel.

The impotent man at Lystra healed.

8 And there sat a certain man at
Lystra, impotent in his feet, being a
cripple from his mother's womb,
who never had walked:
9 The same heard Paul speak:
who stedfastly beholding him, and
perceiving that he had faith to be
healed, word of knowledge
10 Said with a loud voice, Stand
upright on thy feet. And he
leaped and walked.
11 And when the people saw what
Paul had done, they lifted up their
voices, saying in the speech of
Lycaonia, The gods are come down
to us in the likeness of men.
12 And they called Barnabas,
Jupiter; and Paul, Mercurius, be-
cause he was the chief speaker.
13 Then the priest of Jupiter,
which was before their city, brought
oxen and garlands unto the gates,
and would have done sacrifice with
the people. Wreath
14 Which when the apostles, Bar-
nabas and Paul, heard of, they rent
their clothes, and ran in among
the people, crying out,
15 And saying, Sirs, why do ye
these things? We also are men of
like passions with you, and preach
unto you that ye should turn from
these vanities unto the living God,
which made heaven, and earth, and
the sea, and all things that are
therein: CREATOR Rom 1:25
16, Who in times past suffered all
nations to walk in their own ways.
17 Nevertheless he left not himself
without witness, in that he did
good, and gave us rain from
heaven, and fruitful seasons, filling
our hearts with food and gladness.
18 And with these sayings scarce
restrained they the people, that
they had not done sacrifice unto
them.

Paul stoned at Lystra.

19 And there came thither cer-
tain Jews from Antioch and
Iconium, who persuaded the people,
and, having stoned Paul, drew
him out of the city, supposing he
had been dead. People foolish enough to worship are
fickle enough to kill you

Further ministry of the first missionary journey.

20 Howbeit, as the disciples stood
round about him, he rose up, and
came into the city: and the next
day he departed with Barnabas to
Derbe.
