What is to be done when people are seemingly unreachable?

- 1. No one is <u>unapproachable</u> (5:1-5)
 - a. Jesus approaches in spite of our home situation
 - b. Jesus approaches in spite of our **horrible behavior**
 - c. Jesus approaches in spite of the **hopelessness** of our case
- 2. No one is <u>uncontrollable</u> 5:6-17
 - a. We need a divine appointment with Jesus. Verses 6-7
 - b. We need a direct intervention by Jesus verses 8-11
 - i. Jesus will call out our problems by name
 - ii. Jesus will call out our problems by number
 - c. We need a definite confirmation of conversion verses 14-17
 - i. The change will be evident to you
 - ii. The change will be evident to others
- 3. No one is unredeemable. 5:18-20
 - a. Only Jesus can change your desires
 - b. Only Jesus can change your significance
 - c. Only Jesus can change your standing

The only person beyond Jesus' reach is the one that does not come!
