- A. The meat offering involved no bloodshed; so it was dependent upon the burnt offering.
- B. What did it mean for Israel? How did it point to Christ? And what does it say to us about a life of holiness?

Old Testament Sacrifices (1) The Meat Offering

I.	The	Ingredients.
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- A. God specified which ingredients Israel was to use, partly because these ingredients taught Israel about herself.
- B. These ingredients also pointed to Jesus Christ, the true and pure Israelite.
- C. These ingredients speak to all today who will worship Jehovah in true faith.
