If there is something I don't understand I read it anyway. Sometimes the next year when I read it again, I do understand that part. Each year I have a different need in my life. God says that we are to continue to study in order to show ourselves "*approved unto God*," not unto men. We must not be arrogant and boasting in front of people about our knowledge of the Bible. That's not the purpose for our studying. *special emergency*, *e.g. an examination; to 'get up'.*"
