- 4. How should we understand the qualifications Paul gives regarding the wife's call to submit herself to her husband (to her own husband, as to the Lord, in everything)?
- 5. How does this passage and the context of submission make us more thankful for Jesus' work on our behalf? How does this affect how we treat one another in the church?
