Esau's Rejection Genesis 27:30-40

Main Point:

Esau's rejection is a warning to you; learn from it today.

- 1. It's possible to be a professing Christian and yet not receive the salvation hoped for.
- 2. When this happens, there will be absolutely nothing that can be done about it.
- 3. Instead, you will be cursed by God.

- 4. This rejection in the future will be due to your profaneness in the present.
- 5. Learn from the warning of Esau's rejection today.

Hebrews 12:15-17 ¹⁵ ... [Look] carefully lest anyone fall short of the grace of God; lest any root of bitterness springing up cause trouble, and by this many become defiled; ¹⁶ lest there *be* any fornicator or profane person like Esau, who for one morsel of food sold his birthright. ¹⁷ For you know that afterward, when he wanted to inherit the blessing, he was rejected, for he found no place for repentance, though he sought it diligently with tears. (NKJV)

John 10:28 ²⁸ "... I give ... [My sheep] eternal life, and they shall never perish; neither shall anyone snatch them out of My hand. (NKJV)

Matthew 7:21-23 ²¹ "Not everyone who says to Me, `Lord, Lord,' shall enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of My Father in heaven. ²² "Many will say to Me in that day, `Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in Your name, cast out demons in Your name, and done many wonders in Your name?' ²³ "And then I will declare to them, `I never knew you; depart from Me, you who practice lawlessness!'
