How to Regain Respect

Key Building Block: **Integrity**Key Opposition: **Duplicity**

"Building a successful life requires integrity because integrity is the cornerstone of moral authority."

Respect is repaired when:

- 1. You **own** your problems verse 1 a great outcry.
 - a. Don't dismiss your problem
 - b. Don't **downplay** your problems
 - c. Don't donate your problems
 - i. Psalm 51:1-5 verse 3 For I acknowledge my transgressions, And my sin *is* always before me.
 - ii. Proverbs 28:13 He who covers his sins will not prosper, But whoever confesses and forsakes *them* will have mercy.;
- 2. You pay the price verse 1-5
 - a. A crumbling life costs other people
 - i. We mortgage our future
 - ii. We **borrow** for the present
 - iii. We **enslave** our children
 - b. Rebuilding a life costs other people too
- 3. You **appreciate** people verses 1-5 (all of those that are in this with you)
 - a. their love
 - b. their labors
 - c. their long term commitment
- 4. You respect other people verse 8 1
 - a. Respectable people respect people
 - b. Respectable people <u>reject disrespect</u>
 - c. Respectable people **respond to respect**
- 5. You go the extra mile- verses 13-19
 - a. You can't just talk repentance you must walk it
 - b. You can't just make a promise you have to perform it
 - c. You can't be guaranteed a reward but you can regain respect
