

“Obedience in Prayer”

Scripture Reading – I Thess. 5:14-24

What does it look like to be “obedient in prayer?”

1. Am I listening to the Holy Spirit?

“Do not quench the Spirit.” (I Thess. 5:19)

2. Am I humble, ready to obey as He leads?

“We urge you, brothers, admonish the idle, encourage the fainthearted, help the weak, be patient with them all. See that no one repays anyone evil for evil, but always seek to do good to one another and to everyone.” (I Thess. 5:14)

3. Am I seeing prayer itself as an act of obedience?

“Moreover, as for me, far be it from me that I should sin against the Lord by ceasing to pray for you...” (I Samuel. 12:23)

Application:

1. This week as you spend time in prayer, take time to listen to the Spirit. When the Spirit of God speaks to you through His Word, are you ready to obey?
2. As you read I Thess 5:14, which areas of obedience are the most difficult to practice?
3. Do you see prayer as “obedience?” Are you ready to obey Him as you spend time this week in prayer?
