I. The Work of an Elder

- A. Pray (1 Thessalonians 5:17; Acts 6:4; 20:36)
- B. Lead by example (1 Timothy 4:12, 15, 16; 5:1-3; 2 Timothy 1:8; 2:3, 7-8, 24; 4:5; Titus 2:7-8, 15; Ephesians 6:12)
- C. Know, teach, preach, and use biblical doctrine (1 Timothy 4:11, 16; 5:21-22; 6:20; 2 Timothy 1:6-8, 13; 2:1-3, 14-15; 3:14-15; Titus 3:1; Ecclesiastes 10:10; Ezra 7:10)
- D. Protect God's flock (1 Peter 5:2; Acts 20:29-31; John 10:12-13; Matthew 18:18)
- E. Help other men become faithful leaders (1 Timothy 5:19-22; 2 Timothy 2:1-2; Titus 1:5; Galatians 2:11-14)
- F. Trust the Chief Shepherd to do his work through you (1 Peter 2:24-25; 5:1-2)

II. The Character of an Elder

- A. Character is the elder's primary qualification!
- B. Character must be proven in other settings
- C. Able to handle conflict in the right way
- D. Able to control himself, and not be controlled by something else (1 Timothy 5:23; Proverbs 31:4-7; Hebrews 13:5)
- E. Other traits and habits: hospitable (1 Timothy 3:15); able to teach (2 Timothy 2:24); loving good (Philippians 4:8); just/righteous/upright; holy (1 Timothy 2:8; Hebrews 7:26); self-controlled; disciplined (1 Corinthians 9:25)

III. Electing Elders

- B. Eligible for election: adult male member of Christ RPC in good standing
- C. Notice of election
- D. People needed to have the election: half of resident communicant members

I Timotheo 3:1-7

- 1 Ni neno la kuaminiwa; mtu akitaka kazi ya askofu, atamani kazi njema.
- 2 Basi imempasa askofu awe mtu asiyelaumika, mume wa mke mmoja, mwenye kiasi na busara, mtu wa utaratibu, mkaribishaji, ajuaye kufundisha;
- 3 si mtu wa kuzoelea ulevi, si mpiga watu; bali awe mpolo; si mtu wa kujadiliana, wala asiwe mwenye kupenda fedha;
- 4 mwenye kuisimamia nyumba yake vema, ajuaye kutiisha watoto katika ustahivu;
- 5 (yaani, mtu asiyejua kuisimamia nyumba yake mwenyewe, atalitunzaje Kanisa la Mungu?)
- 6 Wala asiwe mtu aliyeongoka karibu, asiye akajivuna akaanguka katika hukumu ya Ibilisi.
- 7 Tena imempasa kushuhudiwa mema na watu walio nje; ili asianguke katika lawama na mtego wa Ibilisi.

Tito 1:4-9

- 4 kwa Tito, mwanangu hasa katika imani tuishirikiyo. Neema na iwe kwako na amani zitokazo kwa Mungu Baba na kwa Kristo Yesu Mwokozi wetu.
- 5 Kwa sababu hii nalikuacha Krete, ili uyatengeneze yaliyopunguka, na kuweka wazee katika kila mji kama vile nilivyokuamuru;
- 6 ikiwa mtu hakushitakiwa neno, naye ni mume wa mke mmoja, ana watoto waaminio, wasioshitakiwa kuwa ni wafisadi wala wasiotii.
- 7 Maana imempasa askofu awe mtu asiyeshitakiwa neno ,kwa kuwa ni wakili wa MUNGU;asiwe mtu wa kujipendeza nafsi yake,asiwe mwepesi wa hasira,asiwe mlevi wala mgomvi,asiwe mpenda mapato ya aibu.
- 8 bali awe mkaribishaji, mpenda wema, mwenye kiasi, mwenye haki, mtakatifu, mwenye kudhibiti nafsi yake;
- 9 akilishika lile neno la imani vile vile kama alivyofundishwa, apate kuweza kuwaonya watu kwa mafundisho yenye uzima, na kuwashinda wenye kupinga.
