- Focus 3 "in the breaking of bread" or the ______ this celebration was reflective of the Gospel and was to be done "in remembrance" of their Savior and Lord and with thanks for His finished work.
- **Focus 4** "_____" this involved group or corporate prayers uttered from needy and thankful hearts in response to the Word of God with praise, supplication, and intercession.

- "as is the _____ of ____" the word "manner" (ethos) refers to manner, custom, or habit.
- "but _____" (parakaleo) can mean to exhort, encourage, or comfort another depending upon its nuance in the context.
- "and so _____ the ____" and even more so or all the more. This expresses the urgency and importance of not neglecting the local church gathering.
