

Moving Toward 4th Dimensional Living

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Thanks for joining me for this episode. Last time, we discussed the Great Invocation as dictated by Alice Bailey's spirit guide she called The Tibetan. We noted how the invocation spoke of love and moving humanity in the same direction though self-effort.

So what is the problem with this message of the Great Invocation? In fact, *is* there a problem with it? Unfortunately, there is truth mixed with error. Yes, this world is under *one* god and according to the Bible, Satan is the prince of this world and the prince of the powers of the air. As God allows, Satan controls all that this world contains (cf. Ephesians 2:2; 5:8; 6:12; John 12:31).

Recall that when Satan tempted Jesus in the wilderness, he (Satan) offered Jesus all the kingdoms of this world (cf. Matthew 4). At no time did Jesus argue with Satan about ownership. He recognized that Satan was the owner (though not the rightful one) of this planet.

Refer again to the quote above and note the last sentence that I have bolded. Read it twice. If that isn't the most pained gobbledy-gook jargon, I don't know what is, do you? "*...wherein we shall demonstrate that love intelligently.*" What, pray tell, does *that* mean? It's like trying to discern the meaning of the ramblings of a politician. They speak in platitudes and they say essentially *nothing*, though they are masters at saying the kind of things that people want to hear.

Our current president says one thing and does another, yet people continue to applaud his speeches. Most recently, because of the current situation in Libya, the UN voted to create a no-fly zone over Libya. Soon, Mr. Obama was on the TV (from Brazil, loaning them money for offshore oil digs), telling the world that the U.S. would have primarily an *advisory* role in the situation.

Within a day, war planes and jets were flying over Libya dropping missiles. In fact, it appeared that the U.S. was leading the way. Several days later, Mr. Obama stated that he was confident that he would be able to hand off the actual military movement to others, while the U.S. *went* to an advisory role.

The problem of course is that Mr. Obama had no backing from Congress to enter into a war situation (which is why it was called a "kinetic military action"). Further, he seems to have lied about the U.S. involvement.

This is the problem with politicians. Most of them say what they need to say to scratch people's ears. They seem intent on doing whatever they want to do for their own expedient gains.

This is exactly what aliens are doing, in my view. It must be *proved* that aliens have the best interests of human beings at heart. If that cannot be proven, then why should they be believed? The people who trust them implicitly seem like the same individuals who support politicians in spite of their lying, their double talk, and their insincerity. People like that are easily taken in because they go by the way things make them *feel*. Is there a problem with that? There certainly is, and it is the very thing that aliens seem to capitalize on in order to break down the natural resistance that is seated within human beings. Living in the *fourth* dimension. It's what Marty had consistent problems with in the movie trilogy, *Back to the Future*. You'll recall Doc Brown telling Marty, "*You're not thinking fourth dimensionally, Marty!*" to which Marty would respond, "*Yeah, I have a tough time with that,*" or something similar.

The Plan of God, according to Lucis Trust (founded by Alice A. Bailey) and the New Age movement, is to hasten humanity's graduation from our *current* level of existence to the *next* level of existence. The next level is what they term *fourth dimensional living*. Fourth dimensional living is living as God lives. Only God or His created spirit beings can traverse from the third dimension to the fourth and back again. Who does not want to be able to do this?

The trouble with *The Plan of God* as explained by occultists and New Agers is that it is done through *self-effort*, for one. Additionally, the meaning of Christian-sounding terms is completely different, leading people to believe that they understand the meanings because they've heard them so often, when in point of fact, a new meaning has been applied. This is no different from dealing with people in cults. They often use Christian-sounding terms and phrases, but their meanings are far removed from orthodox or original meanings.

The Plan of God is a plan that is based on *works* and *deception*. Man is led to believe through deceptive means that he must work toward a type of salvation. This salvation is found allegedly within the realm of *fourth dimension living*. Humanity individually and collectively puts in the effort through meditation and acts of goodwill toward other human beings, animals, and the earth. As more people become completely enmeshed in the concept of spiritually meditating for world peace and love, as well as actually physically involving themselves in the process by doing good works for other people, the world moves toward that stage where people will become divine and live fourth dimensionally.

This can only occur when all people unite as one. With one mind, one purpose, and one vision, all people can do together what Nimrod failed (due to God's direct intervention) to do in Genesis 11. Nimrod – a hunter of men – was the world's first dictator, if you like. He

was so passionate about what he wanted and worked so hard to bring all people together in one purpose that had God not intervened, it is clear from the text of Genesis that Nimrod would have achieved what he set out to achieve.

We are living in 2011 and yet the message that is being channeled from the fourth dimension to us is as old as Nimrod. Little if anything has changed.

All around us, books, movies, conferences, and more teach us that we must unite. The world is becoming smaller due to technology. We see a tsunami off the coast of Japan *as it happens*. We see and vicariously experience the destruction of that same tsunami on the upper portion of Japan.

We are constantly being told through a variety of sources that if we do not unite under the banner of one purpose, we will be lost. In essence, then, people are being told that the path to God is actually done without going *through* God. Why would we need to *go* to God if we are actually already gods? That would be a bit redundant, wouldn't it?
