3. The value of the speech of the godly in comparison to the ungodly.

*The Heidelberg Catechism*

**112. Q.** What is required in the ninth commandment?

**A.** I must not give false testimony against anyone, twist no one's words, not gossip or slander, nor condemn or join in condemning anyone rashly and unheard.[1] Rather, I must avoid all lying and deceit as the devil's own works, under penalty of God's heavy wrath.[2] In court and everywhere else, I must love the truth,[3] speak and confess it honestly, and do what I can to defend and promote my neighbor's honor and reputation.[4]

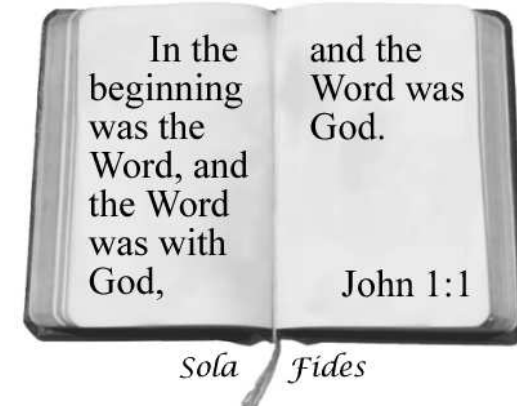
