III. THE DETAILS OF OBSERVING THE 5<sup>TH</sup>

#### I. The reason for the 5<sup>th</sup>

A. The traditional view sees the 5<sup>th</sup> as *the first of the second table* (Eph. 6:2)

B. Why does God start our duties to our neighbor with the 5<sup>th</sup>?

1. Because God the keys to promote and protect our happiness: **honor**

***His authority structures***

a. most basic is the *family life structure*

b. nothing is more foundation for *our personal well-being as family*

#### II. The incentive in keeping the 5<sup>th</sup> commandment?

A. God promises the *long days* (Ex. 20:12; Deut. 5:16)

1. How understand the *long days – prolonged day – go well with us?*

a. either *long life of many happy days*

b. or a *life of happy days as long as it lasts* (Deut 5:16, 29, 33)

2. Prov. 14:34: *righteousness (law-abiding) exalts a nation (prolongs)*

a. such right living is taught in family life

#### III. What are the details of the 5<sup>th</sup> commandment?

A. This 5<sup>th</sup> is far broader than can be covered in one sermon

1. Besides the subjects, the 5<sup>th</sup> is also God's will for leaders

a. which leaders?

b. which subjects

B. What are the 3 *aspects* in honoring those in authority over me?

1<sup>st</sup> That we recognize that **God is pleased** to *rule us by their hand*

a. each person given (delegated) *authority* is God's *office-bearer*

2<sup>nd</sup> That we **honor** God's representative or office-bearers

a. Definition of *showing honor*

● do we honor the *person* or the *office of the person*

b. How do we honor God's office-bearers?

c. What exception does God allow? Acts 5:19

● each parent ought to teach this principle – boundary

3<sup>rd</sup> That we bear with their weakness, limits or infirmities

a. none of God's office bearers is perfect

b. being sinners, leaders can fail in leading or example

c. it is God's will to *press Master's footsteps*: Luke 2:51-52

C. What is God's will for office-bearers (authority figures)?

1. That in all my actions/ reactions as authority figure *I resemble Him*

a. office-bearers are *stewards to govern on God's behalf*

● as husbands

● as parents (teachers, baby-sitters)

● as government officials (police)

● as church leaders

2. God's clear warning to the abuse of authority

a. either in selfish or angry use (Eph. 6:4; Col. 3:21)

b. or in neglect of using delegated authority (Prov. 29:15)
