Consequences of Rebellion (7-14)

- Weeping
- Emptiness
- Removal from community
- Suffering of the land
- Wrath of God
- Fear and hopelessness
- Consider these both temporal and eternal

The Blessings of Redemption (15-24)

- The Picture of the Righteous
 - Walks (lives) in righteousness
 - Speaks in sincerity
 - Rejects injustice (especially as it relates to wealth)
 - Does not ponder violence
 - Closes eyes to evil
- What will come for the one grace has touched?
 - Dwell on the heights (what we long for) (16)
 - Security (refuge)
 - Provision (Bread and water)
 - See the King (17)
 - Behold a “distant land” (Hebrews 11:13-16)
 - Rightly considers judgment (18)
 - Will cease seeing oppressors (19)
 - See and enjoy the remade heavens and earth (20)
 - Enjoy the very presence of God (21-22)
- How is all this possible? (23-24)
 - Acknowledgement of inability
 - Acceptance of grace and forgiveness
