## Lord Day 17; I Corinthians 15 Introduction

- A. With the resurrection, Jesus continued his labors for us, but now in the state of exaltation.
- B. In Lord's Day 17, the Catechism presents the resurrection to us as being profitable.

## Benefiting from Christ's Resurrection

- I. The Belief Expressed
- A. From beginning to end, the Scriptures give us reason to confess Christ's resurrection from the dead.
  - 1. The gospel accounts present Jesus' resurrection as something that Jesus both *predicted* and *accomplished*.
  - 2. I Corinthians 15:4 points out that the resurrection has *always* been believed, for Jesus arose "according to the Scriptures."
- B. The Catechism's language teaches the essence of the resurrection.
  - 1. By his resurrection, Jesus "has overcome death."
  - 2. The proof that Jesus overcame death is found in the "new life" that he possessed after his resurrection.
