- I. BABYLON IS NOT A JEWISH THEOCRACY AND THE UNITED STATES IS NOT A CHRISTIAN THEOCRACY

 - A. Nebuchadnezzar proud, arrogant, outbursts
 - B. Cyrus pagan with a sense of destiny
