He received a fellowship to All Souls College, and later became Rector at Hodnet, Shropshire, England. In 1823, he became, somewhat reluctantly, Bishop of Calcutta, India.)

(Words: **Edward Perronet** 1726-1792 Perronet, son of an Anglican minister, descended from French Huguenots who fled the continent to escape religious persecution. For a time, Perronet was a co-worker of [HYPERLINK "http://www.cyberhymnal.org/bio/w/e/s/wesley_j.htm"](http://www.cyberhymnal.org/bio/w/e/s/wesley_j.htm) **John** and [HYPERLINK "http://www.cyberhymnal.org/bio/w/e/s/wesley_c.htm"](http://www.cyberhymnal.org/bio/w/e/s/wesley_c.htm) **Charles Wesley**. John Wesley was always trying to get him to preach, but Perronet, though capable, was somewhat in awe of Wesley, and always deferred to him. Any time John Wesley was present, Perronet felt Wesley should do the preaching. But John Wesley was not one to take "no" for an answer. So, one day, in the middle of a meeting, he simply announced, "Brother Perronet will now speak." Thinking quickly, Perronet stood before the large crowd and declared, "I will now deliver the greatest sermon ever preached on earth" (you can imagine he got everyone's attention). He then read the Sermon on the Mount, and sat down.)

The Attributes of God

Adopter

Romans 8:15-17 For you have not received a spirit of slavery leading to fear again, but you have received a spirit of adoption as sons by which we cry out, "Abba! Father!" The Spirit Himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God, and if children, heirs also, heirs of God and fellow heirs with Christ, if indeed we suffer with Him in order that we may also be glorified with Him.

Galatians 4:4-7 But when the fullness of the time came, God sent forth His Son, born of a woman, born under the Law, in order that He might redeem those who were under the Law, that we might receive the adoption as sons. And because you are sons, God has sent forth the Spirit of His Son into our hearts, crying, "Abba! Father!" Therefore you are no longer a slave, but a son; and if a son, then an heir through God.

Ephesians 1:5-6 He predestined us to adoption as sons through Jesus Christ to Himself, according to the kind intention of His will, to the praise of the glory of His grace, which He freely bestowed on us in the Beloved.

Psalm 32:5 I acknowledged my sin to Thee, And my iniquity I did not hide; I said, "I will confess my transgressions to the Lord"; And Thou didst forgive the guilt of my sin.

Psalm 86:5 For Thou, Lord, art good, and ready to forgive, And abundant in lovingkindness to all who call upon Thee.

Psalm 130:3 If Thou, Lord, shouldst mark iniquities, O Lord, who could stand?

Psalm 130:4 But there is forgiveness with Thee, That Thou mayest be feared.

Freedom/Unfettered

Psalm 115:3 But our God is in the heavens; He does whatever He pleases.

Psalm 47:4 He chooses our inheritance for us, the glory of Jacob whom He loves. Selah.

Mark 13:20 "And unless the Lord had shortened those days, no life would have been saved; but for the sake of the elect whom He chose, He shortened the days.

Psalm 116:5 Gracious is the Lord, and righteous; Yes, our God is compassionate.

Jeremiah 3:12 "Go, and proclaim these words toward the north and say, 'Return, faithless Israel,' declares the LORD; 'I will not look upon you in anger. For I am gracious,' declares the LORD; 'I will not be angry forever.

Grief/Sorrow

Hate/Hatred

Ps 5:5 The boastful shall not stand before Thine eyes; Thou dost hate all who do iniquity.

Jer 44:4 'Yet I sent you all My servants the prophets, again and again, saying, "Oh, do not do this abominable thing which I hate."

Rom 9:13-16 Just as it is written, "Jacob I loved, but Esau I hated." What shall we say then? There is no injustice with God, is there? May it never be! For He says to Moses, "I will have mercy on whom I have mercy, and I will have compassion on whom I have compassion." So then it does not depend on the man who wills or the man who runs, but on God who has mercy.

Heb 1:8-9 But of the Son He says, "Thy throne, O God, is forever and ever, and the righteous scepter is the scepter of His kingdom. "Thou hast loved righteousness and hated lawlessness; therefore God, Thy God, hath anointed Thee with the oil of gladness above Thy companions."

Psalm 113:5-6 Who is like the LORD our God, who is enthroned on high, Who humbles himself to behold the things that are in heaven and in the earth?

Matthew 11:28-30 "Come to Me, all who are weary and heavy-laden, and I will give you rest. Take My yoke upon you, and learn from Me, for I am gentle and humble in heart; and you shall find rest for your souls. For My yoke is easy, and My load is light."

Philippians 2:6-8 who, although He existed in the form of God, did not regard equality with God a thing to be grasped, but emptied Himself, taking the form of a bond-servant, and being made in the likeness of men. A Personal Study Project:

Many teach that the God of the Old Testament is a God of Wrath and that the God of the New Testament is the God of Love.
