1. Break away from the _____,

Prov.28:19; He that tilleth his land shall have plenty of bread: but he that followeth after vain *persons* shall have poverty enough.

Proverb 12:11: He that tilleth his land shall be satisfied with bread: but he that followeth vain persons is void of understanding.

_____, v.20

Prov.28:20; A faithful man shall abound with blessings: but he that maketh haste to be rich shall not be innocent.

3. Break away from _____,
v.20,22

Prov.28:20; A faithful man shall abound with blessings: but he that **maketh haste** to be rich shall not be innocent.

Prov.28:22: He that **hasteth** to be rich *hath* an evil eye, and considereth not that poverty shall come upon him.

- Some are in a **worry** to be rich!
