Discussion Questions Lecture One

I. Have someone read the passages on the Marriage Covenant made with God – Malachi 2:14; Proverbs 2:17

- A. Most people think of a wedding as a union between two people, two families, blessed by God.
 - 1. How is a Covenant or Oath made with and to God different from an oath or vow made between two people or two families?
 - 2. The wedding is a public oath made to God by the man and the woman, how is this different than asking God for His blessing on your vows to each other?
 - 3. If a wedding is simply a ceremony where two individuals or families make commitments to each other and then ask the blessing of God, what is necessary to dissolve this union?
 - 4. If a wedding is where the church and families assemble to witness an oath or vow made by the couple to God joining them in a Covenant with God what is necessary to break this Covenant?

B. Have someone read Matthew 19:4-6. Is God willing for any man to break this covenant?

- 1. Does that include the state and the church?
- Does that include the couple who made the vow?
- 3. Why do people think they can break the Covenant and get a divorce?
- 4. Since God does not recognize the authority of man in this area, what does that say about divorce courts and divorce in the sight of God?
- 5. How does this help us understand Mark 10:11 & 12?

II. Now have someone read Malachi 2:14 – 17

- A. When a divorce occurs two sins are committed one in verse 15 and one in verse 16. What are these sins?
- B. In verse 16 how does God feel about divorce?
- C. Some people say that divorce is no big deal, that it is in fact "good", that God is not a God of justice and does not care if you get a divorce. What does verse 17 say about these people who say that divorce is not big deal?

III. Now have someone read Proverbs 2:12 – 19

- A. In verses 12 17 how does God describe those who would allow a woman to divorce her husband and take up with another man?
- B. In verses 16 and 17 how does God describe the woman who would break her covenant vow and take up with another man?
- C. In verses 18 & 19 what will be the end of this woman who breaks her Covenant Vow with God?

IV. According to Malachi 2:17 and Proverbs 2:12 & 13 will there be men and women who condone divorce?

- A. How does God describe these people?
- B. What will they do with God's Word when it comes to divorce?
- C. Who does this remind you of? (Genesis 3:1-4)
- D. What reasonings did the devil use to deceive Eve into disobeying God?
- E. What reasonings do those deceived by satan today use to deceive Christians into believing divorce is a good and valid option?
- V. In the Marriage Covenant we are swearing to meet legitimate needs. Not all needs are a result of sin. Some needs are legitimate and created by God. What are some of these legitimate needs which God instilled in man at his creation? (Genesis 2:11; Psalm 127:2; Genesis 2:15; Genesis 2:16; Genesis 2:18; Genesis 2:24 & 25; Genesis 1:28)
 - A. As you become more spiritual will these needs go away?
 - B. Your spouse has legitimate needs created by God. As your spouse becomes more spiritual will these needs lessen and eventually go away?
- VI. Have someone read Ephesians 5:22 28. In the two relationships who is serving and who is being served? (Mark 10:45; Luke 9:23 and 22:24 27)?
 - A. Does the church serve Christ? What does that say about the wife in marriage?
 - B. Does Christ love and serve the church? What does that say about the husband in marriage?
