Examine the Scriptures (Be Berean!)

- John 9 -- Whole Chapter as Necessary Context
- Jesus as light: John 1:4; 8:12; 9:5; 12:35

Consider & Discuss (Be Transformed!)

- What did Jesus disciples assume about the relationship between sin and blindness (2)?
- What did Jesus do to their thinking? What should this alert us to? How should we be in regards to our thinking (3)?
- What does it mean that "the works of God" be "displayed in" people (3)? Examples?
- What was the time of "day" during Jesus' earthly ministry? What was the "night" He said "was coming (4)?"
- Why was their a window of opportunity for working only during the "day" and not at "night" (4)?
- How does verse 5 answer the questions above?
- Rehearse what we have already seen regarding Jesus as light (1:4, 8:12). Read John 12:35.
- Note the peculiar way Jesus healed the blind man (6-7) and then comment on any significance of this way.
- How much of the following context pertains to this healing?
- **Community Group Question: How does Jesus' healing of the man born blind help us understand Jesus?**
