Connecting The Dots With Love.

I Text:

Old Covenant: Jeremiah 29:1-14
New Covenant: Romans 8:28-39

II Doctrine: The living God whom we worship has revealed himself in nature and Holy Scripture. The love our God has for us is grounded in the truth and faithfulness of his word. Our God will always guide and lead his faithful remnant through their time of captivity, until our deliverance is at hand. God's people have outlasted the Babylonian and Roman Empires by leading simple and faithful lives. We will outlast this New World Order and "Globalism" the same way.

The empty "love" the world offers us leads to death and destruction. False prophets spread the lies of their father the devil. They preach to the world that lawlessness is true worship. God cleanses his Church from such filth by the truth of his word. God's love is active even in times of judgment.
