Obadiah announces God's End Time judgment against Israel's twin brother Esau – known here as Edom. God accuses Edomof violence against his brother Jacob....not just one event, but systematic, unrelenting, escalating VIOLENCE gainst ISRAEL


This indictment included Edom's physical & spiritual descendants for their cruel, sadistic, and horrific crimes against family bloodlines in Genesis....all the way until now. Who are these modern day Edomites?

God's Wrath is over repeated attempts to dispossess His People, the Jews from His Land, Israel & specifically His Holy Mountain in Jerusalem, the Temple Mount.

History records Babylon's Invasion of Israel and the destruction of the Temple in 586 BC. Then the Roman Invasion of Israel and Temple destruction in 70AD. In modern times, Islam has seized the Temple Mount and built the Dome of the Rock & AAsqa Mosque in its place

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B. Nations That Honor God Find Refuge.




God's Pronouncement of Judgment on Edom:

Ps. 33:12








1 The vision of Obadiah Thus saith the Lord GOD concerning Edom; We have heard a rumour from the LORD, and an ambassador is sent among the heathen, Arise ye, and let us rise up against her in battle. (KJV)


¹ This is the **prophecy of** Obadiah—what the Sovereign LORD said about the nation of Edom. The LORD has sent his messenger to the nations, and we have heard his message: "Get ready ! Let us go to war against Edom!(TEV)





² Behold, I have made thee small among the heathen: thou art greatly despised. (KJV)

² The LORD says to Edom, "I will make you weak; everyone will despise you. **(TEV)**





3 The pride of thine heart hath deceived thee, thou that dwellest in the clefts of the rock, whose habitation is high; that saith in his heart, Who shall bring me down to the ground? (KJV)

³ Your pride has deceived you. Your capital is a fortress of solid rock; your home is high in the mountains, and so you say to yourself, 'Who Can ever pull me down?' (TEV)



⁴ Though thou exalt thyself as the eagle, and though thou set thy nest among the stars, thence will I bring thee down, saith the LORD.

⁴ Even though you make your home as high as an eagle's nest, so that it seems to be among the stars, yet I will pull you down. (TEV)






5 If thieves came to thee, if robbers by night, (how art thou cut off!) would they not have stolen till they had enough? if the grapegatherers came to thee, would they not leave some grapes?

⁵ "When thieves come at night, they take only what they want. When people gather grapes, they always leave a few. But your enemies have wiped you out completely. (TEV)



6 How are the things of Esau searched out! how are his hidden things sought up! (KJV)

⁶ Descendants of Esau, your treasures have been looted. (TEV)





7 All the men of thy confederacy have brought thee even to the border: the men that were at peace with thee have deceived thee, and prevailed against thee; they that eat thy bread have laid a wound under thee: there is none understanding in him. (KJV)


⁷ Your allies have deceived you; they have driven you from your country. People who were at peace with you have now conquered you. Those friends who ate with you have laid a trap for you; they say of you, 'Where is all that cleverness he had?'(TEV)





8 Shall I not in that day, saith the LORD, even destroy the wise men out of Edom, and understanding out of the mount of Esau? (KJV)

8 "On the day I punish Edom, I will destroy their clever men and wipe out all their wisdom. (TEV)





9 And thy mighty men, O Teman, shall be dismayed, to the end that every one of the mount of Esau may be cut off by slaughter. (KJV)

⁹ The fighting men of Teman will be terrified, and every soldier in Edom will be killed. **(TEV)**

"For what shall it profit a man, if he shall gain the whole world, and lose his own soul? Or what shall a man give in exchange for his soul? Whosoever therefore shall be ashamed of me and of my words in this adulterous and sinful generation; of him also shall the Son of man be ashamed, when he cometh in the glory of his Father with the holy angels" (Mk. 8:36-38).



Conclusion

Obadiah is a reminder that God is watching, and on the "day of the Lord" He will bring judgment upon the nations that have defied Him and blessing on those who have followed Him.

The prophet presented the nations with two roads:

- a road to ruin
- a road to refuge and restoration.

Just as it was true for the nations, so is it also true for us as individuals. The path that one takes determines everything about the future that one faces.

Everyone must choose his or her own road, but do not be naïve and believe that God is not watching or aware of the road that we take
