- A. Jesus Desires His Disciples to Be with Him (v 24).
 - 1. The request
 - 2. The reason for this request: "to see my glory"
 - 3. The nature of Jesus' glory
- B. Those who know the righteous Father (v 25)
 - 1. Those who do *not* know the Father
 - 2. Those who do know the Father: Jesus and the disciples
- C. Jesus has revealed and will continue to reveal the Father's name (v 26).
 - 1. Jesus has revealed the Father
 - 2. Jesus will continue reveal the Father
 - 3. The reason Jesus reveals the Father
 - a. That the Father's love for Jesus may be in us
 - b. That Jesus may be in us

III. The End of the Pursuit

- A. 1 Jn 3:1-3 gives us God's intended response to Jn 17:24-26.
- B. If we are destined to see Jesus' glory, we ought to purify ourselves now and find our happiness in Jesus.
