## "THE HIGHEST EXAMPLE OF HUMILITY"

Philippians 2:5-11

**INTRO:** How low did Christ go when He humbled Himself? "All of you be subject one to another, and be <u>clothed with humility . . ."</u>

## YOU AND I NEED TO FOLLOW CHRIST'S EXAMPLE OF HUMBLE-MINDEDNESS

How? By making two features of Christ's humility part of your life.

- ALTHOUGH HE WAS GOD, <u>HE WAS WILLING TO SURRENDER HIMSELF</u> (v. 6 - 7)
  - A. CHRIST SURRENDERED IN <u>FULL AWARENESS</u> OF HIS ATTRIBUTES (deity) (v. 6 7a)
  - B. CHRIST SURRENDERED THE <u>INDEPENDENT DISPLAY</u> OF HIS ATTRIBUTES (deity) (v. 7b-c)
    - 1. By becoming a <u>Servant</u> (v. 7b)
    - 2. By becoming a <u>Man</u> (v. 7c)

## II. BECAUSE HE BECAME MAN, <u>HE WAS WILLING TO SUBMIT HIMSELF</u> (V. 8-11)

- A. HIS SUBMISSIVENESS LED TO <u>SACRIFICE</u> (V. 8A)
- B. HIS SUBMISSIVENESS LED TO <u>HUMILIATION</u> (V.8b)
- C. HIS SUBMISSIVENESS LED TO <u>EXALTATION</u> (V. 9-11).
  - 1. Christ's Reward (v. 9) "A name above all names"
  - 2. Christ's Recognition (v. 10-11) "Every knee . . . every tongue"
