Rooted in the OT -- Lev. 19:33-34 Why? Ps 106:6 Grace is the hospitality of God to welcome sinners not because of their goodness but because of His glory. Piper

True in the NT -- Eph. 2:11-12, 15-16, 19 Why? Eph. 1:5 *When I practice hospitality to others, I recall the grace of God shown to me.

5. The call to Christian hospitality is a call to look outside myself and my needs to the needs of others. Job 42:10 praying for his friends

6. The call to Christian hospitality is a call to let go of greed and fear and trust God.

7. The call to Christian hospitality is a call to confirm my love to God and obedience to His commands.

1 John 3:16-19; 3 John 3-5a, 11

8. The call to Christian hospitality is a call to participate in the Gospel. 2 Ways:

- By supporting the work of the ministry, we participate in the work of the ministry. 3 John 7-8; 2 John 10-11; Matthew 10:41
 - B. By showing X'n hospitality to others, we participate in the work of the truth in their lives.
