

# "Looking Ahead"

What You Can Expect Genesis 49:1-21

#### Our past:

I. Prevents - "thou shall not excel" (vs. 1-7)

*Infecting with:* 

- A. Vileness "father's bed...defiledst thou it"
- B. Vandalism "in their selfwill they digged down a wall"
- C. Violence "their anger...was fierce...their wrath...cruel"

II. Predicts - "the sceptre shall not depart from Judah" (vs. 8-12)

Influencing our:

- A. Family "whom thy brethren shall praise"
- **B.** Foes "thy hand shall be in the neck of thine enemies"
- C. Fulfillment "His teeth white with milk"

III. Prepares - "I have waited for thy salvation" (vs. 13-21)

Informing our view of:

- A. Pleasure "he saw...rest was good, and the land...pleasant"
- **B.** *Problems* "but he shall overcome at last"
- C. Preparation "a hind let loose: he gives goodly words"

### Sentence Sermon:

Forgetting those things which are behind and reaching toward the mark for the prize of the high calling of God in Christ Jesus." Phil. 3:13-14
