Sermon: "Antichrists Betray Their Own." Pt. 4- What's Wrong With You People? Pt. 29

I Text:

Old Covenant: *Judges 9:50-57*

New Covenant: *Genesis 3:8-15*

II Doctrine:

The nature of an Antichrist never changes through the ages. They always betray their own followers, and fight battles they cannot win. Abimelech continues his onslaught against his former allies by storming Thebez.

Abimelech demonstrates the Antichrist spirit once again by trying to burn all the men, women, and children alive. The people of Thebez retreat to the city tower hoping to survive the assault. Abimelech senses an easy victory but the Lord has other plans!

The living God causes Abimelech to be struck down by a woman in battle. God fulfills the curse he led Jotham to place on this antichrist. This hearkens us back to the Garden of Eden.
