BIBLE DISCUSSION GROUP STUDY QUESTIONS

In preparation for Sunday, October 3, 2021

Memory Passage: 1 John 3:1-2 **DAY 1 – ASK FOR INSIGHT**

READ THE PASSAGE

Passage: 1 John 2:28-3:3

- (a) **Read 1 John 2:28-3:3**. Verse 28 is a verse that could be the end of what precedes or the beginning of what follows. In what ways does it reach back to vs. 18-27? In what ways does it reach forward to 2:29-3:10?
- (b) Explain in detail what you learned last week about "abiding."
- (c) How does abiding in Christ result in (cf. "so that" in v. 28) "confidence" without "shrink(ing)" back at Jesus' coming?
- (d) How will the actions of one who has "confidence" when Christ returns differ from the one who "shrinks back in shame."

DAY 2 – ASK FOR INSIGHT

READ THE PASSAGE

- (a) **Read 1 John 2:28-3:3**. How does one "know that he is righteous?"
- (b) What does it mean to be "born of him" (remember what you have learned about the way John uses the Greek preposition εκ [translated "of"], and if you need a bit more help, see John 1:12-13, 3:1-15, 1 Pet. 1:3-5, 1 John 3:9, 4:7, 5:1, 4, & 18)?
- (c) How do you know what actions identify one who "practices righteousness?" How is this righteous life related to abiding?
- (d) What is the relationship between being born of God and practicing righteousness (i.e., which comes first) & and why does it matter)?

DAY 3 – ASK FOR INSIGHT

READ THE PASSAGE

- (a) **Read 1 John 2:28-3:3**. What kind of love *has* the Father given to us?
- (b) Conduct a word search on "adoption" (5x in ESV) and "children of God" (9x in ESV). Write a paragraph detailing what you learn about being an adopted child of God.
- (c) In what ways does the world not know the adopted children of God?
- (d) What does the fact that the world does not know God have to do with the world not knowing us?

DAY 4 - ASK FOR INSIGHT

READ THE PASSAGE

- (a) **Read 1 John 2:28-3:3**. Why does John emphasize that we are God's children "now?" What is significant about "now?"
- (b) What should believers be expecting ("what we will be has not yet appeared") when he "appears?" (cf. Eph. 4:20-5:2; Phil. 3:19-20; Col. 3:4; Rom. 8:14-17)?
- (c) Is this transformation a process happening "now," or is it entirely future? How does v. 3 inform your answer?
- (d) Why is it necessary for one to "hope in him" in order to engage in this transformational purifying from now to then?

DAY 5 – ASK FOR INSIGHT

READ THE PASSAGE

- (a) **Read 1 John 2:28-3:3**. How is purifying yourself (v. 3) related to practicing righteousness (2:29) and abiding (2:28)?
- (b) How does hoping in Christ now motivate you to pursue sanctification (i.e., "purify" yourself)?
- (c) How does your life look more like Christ and His purity today than it did last week? Last year?
- (d) Re-read the paragraph you wrote on Day 3 (b). In what ways do these truths cause you to rejoice over being adopted by your heavenly Father? In what ways do these truths motivate and empower you toward pure, righteous living?
- (e) In what ways are you challenged by the fact that the world will not know you if your life resembles Jesus? In what ways are you encouraged by the same fact?
- (f) Write down at least three more applications flowing from your study of 1 John 1:28-3:3.
