II. What is the mission (purpose) of the church? I Tim. 3:15 Acts 2:42 I Pe. 2:9

A. GBC Purpose Statement (revised 2010)

God's purpose for the church (I Tim. 3:15), including this local expression of the body of Christ, is that He be glorified (Ephesians 3:10, 21) as we grow in discipleship by:

- 1. Gathering together to worship God in the unity of the Spirit (Acts 2:42; Eph. 4:1-3).
- 2. Exercising our spiritual gifts for the edifying, maturing and equipping of the whole church body (I Corinthians 12:4-7 Eph. 4:11-16 II Timothy 2:2).
- 3. Proclaiming the gospel of God's saving grace to our community and to the world through word and practice (Matthew 28:18-20 Acts 1:8).
- 4. Applying biblical principles to all spheres of life (Mt. 5:13-16 Jer. 29:7 I Co. 10:31 Eph. 5:22-6:9).
- B. We gather together to worship God in the unity of the Spirit (and in truth). Acts 2:42 I Tim. 3:15 John 4:24
 - 1. The church is not the source of truth.
 - 2. We proclaim God's truth to one another. I Ti. 3:15b 4:13 5:17 II Tim. 4:1ff

- B. Christ is the foundation of His church. I Pe. 2:4-8
 - 1. He is the living stone precious to God. v. 4 .
 - 2. We are built up in union with Him as a holy temple. v. 5a
 - 3. We serve as priests offering up spiritual sacrifices through Christ. v. 5b,9
 - 4. Your response to Christ determines everything. v. 7-10
