Acts 4:13

Now when they saw the boldness of Peter and John, and perceived that they were uneducated and untrained men, they marveled. And they realized that they had been with Jesus.

What happens to a Christian that spends time with Jesus?

- 1) We give people **undivided attention** (Acts 3:4)
 - a) **Compassion**
- 2) We give Jesus the **undisputed Glory** (3:13, 16; 4:10)
 - a) **Confidence**
- 3) We give the seeker an **undiluted message** (4:12)
 - a) **Conviction**
- 4) We give the opposition **undeterred boldness** (4:13, 19-20)
 - a) **Courage**
- 5) We give the world **irrefutable evidence** (4:14, 21-22)
 - a) **Change**

What happens to a seeker that has an encounter with Jesus?

- 1) Jesus **sees** where you are – 3:2-3
- 2) Jesus **understands** your need – 3:6
- 3) Jesus **reaches out** in compassion – 3:7
- 4) Jesus will make you **whole** – 3:8-9; 4:14
- 5) Jesus will make **the world marvel** through you – 3:10-11; 4:22
