JOHN: The glory of Jesus—Part 26

Sermon: **John 14:6a**

The glory of Jesus in being the way and the truth.

We see:

1. Jesus is *the way*.
2. Jesus is *the truth*.
3. As *the truth*, Jesus also sends the *Spirit of truth*.

The Westminster Confession of Faith

WCF 8.1 It pleased God, in His eternal purpose, to choose and ordain the Lord Jesus, His only begotten Son, to be the Mediator between God and man;(1) the Prophet,(2) Priest,(3) and King;(4) the Head and Savior of His Church;(5) the Heir of all things;(6) and Judge of the world;(7) unto whom He did from all eternity give a people, to be His seed,(8) and to be by Him in time redeemed, called, justified, sanctified, and glorified.(9)

WCF 8.5 The Lord Jesus, by His perfect obedience and sacrifice of Himself, which He, through the eternal Spirit, once offered up unto God, hath fully satisfied the justice of His Father;(1) and purchased, not only reconciliation, but an everlasting inheritance in the kingdom of heaven, for all those whom the Father hath given unto Him.(2)

WCF 25.2 The visible Church, which is also catholic or universal under the Gospel (not confined to one nation, as before under the law), consists of all those throughout the world that profess the true religion;(1) and of their children:(2) and is the kingdom of the Lord Jesus Christ,(3) the house and family of God,(4) out of which there is no ordinary possibility of salvation.(5)

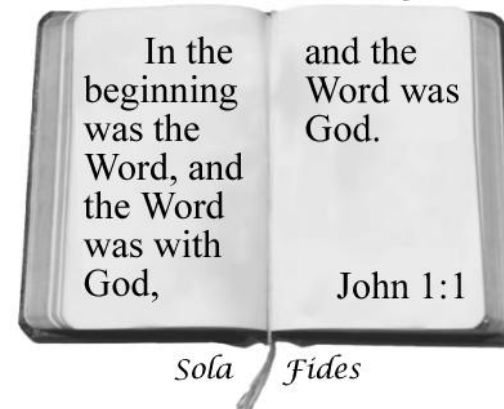

Questions for discussion

[Sermon: John 14:6a]

1. Why are the disciples full of a mixture of thoughts and emotions?
2. Why does Jesus say *I am the way*?! (what is the context?)
3. To what/where is Jesus *the way*?
4. Since Jesus is *the way*...and He has gone there, what does that say about *His own* as they are here?
5. Jesus is *the way* but what is another *way*, and where does it lead to? What is the difference in these two?
6. What does *from now on* (v.7) refer to and what is so very important in that *from now on*?
7. What *works* will the disciples do as Jesus has gone away?
How will Jesus enable them to do these *works*?
