

# Unit 4, Lesson 15, Psalms, Part II

## DAILY READINGS

Again, we will approach the lesson's readings combined with the questions. For full introduction of Psalms, and 43 of David's works, see Lesson 14. This lesson will cover the other 32 Psalms of David, plus 27 Psalms by other authors. Next week we will conclude Psalms with 48 anonymous ones.

**Day One.** The "Help Me!" Psalms of David. Read carefully Psalms 4, 13, 17, 39, 55, and 61.
