Timeline: August 605 BC - Babylon.

Four teenagers versus Babylon

- 1. They were **<u>forced</u>** to assimilate
 - a. They were given **<u>rigorous</u>** training (verse 3-4)
 - b. They were appointed a **<u>regal</u>** diet (verse 5)
 - c. They were assigned **<u>religious</u>** identities. (verses 6-7)
 - d. God gave Nebuchadnezzar the **<u>right to rule</u>**. (verses 1-2)
 - i. Guess what! God gives **position and power** to people that we would not chose.
- 2. They were **<u>faced</u>** with a test (verses 8-16)
 - a. They survived the testing by **inner conviction** (verse 8a)
 - i. <u>**Convictions**</u> are predetermined decisions concerning possible choices in life.
 - b. They passed the test through a **wise appeal** (verse 8b-16)
 - c. They excelled in the test by **Divine Favor** (verses 9-10; 15-16)
- 3. They were **<u>found</u>** to be Superior. (verse 17-21)
 - a. God gave them grace to learn (verse 17)
 - b. God gave them grace to excel (verse 18)
 - c. God gave them grace to serve (verse 19)

Take this with you:

We should not be asking how to get out of a <u>circumstance</u> but rather what can I get out of this <u>situation</u>?

So what is our attitude toward government to be? "Government is **good** but government is not **God**."
