## ROCK SOLID LIFE

### I. KNOW THE PLAN FOR UNSHAKABLE

*“but grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. To Him be the glory both now and forever. Amen.”*  
II Peter 3:18

Our UNSHAKABLE campaign is a spiritual growth campaign that shows people how to stand strong when things go wrong.

This campaign is for every person in our church and community, and it uses the power of alignment at three levels to help us put these actions into practice:

Congregational Level – we are having a series of twelve “UNSHAKABLE SERMONS” dealing with the top storms of life that shake our lives.

Group Level – we are providing “UNSHAKABLE SMALL GROUPS” where people can connect together and talk about each topic.

Imagine the impact in our lives if through this campaign we all learned how to be UNSHAKABLE.

### II. APPLY THE PASSAGE FOR UNSHAKABLE

*“24 Therefore whoever hears these sayings of Mine, and does them, I will liken him to a wise man who built his house on the rock:*

*25 and the rain descended, the floods came, and the winds blew and beat on that house; and it did not fall, for it was founded on the rock.*

*26 “But everyone who hears these sayings of Mine, and does not do them, will be like a foolish man who built his house on the sand:*

*27 and the rain descended, the floods came, and the winds blew and beat on that house; and it fell. And great was its fall.”*

*28 And so it was, when Jesus had ended these sayings, that the people were astonished at His teaching,*

*29 for He taught them as one having authority, and not as the scribes.”*
