- I. Israel had been delivered from Egypt and now was camped at the base of Mt. Sinai.
- II. As we consider this blessing, there are a few things we must keep in mind.

Jehovah's Core Covenant Blessing

I. Promised Fellowship

- A. The text is a covenant promise of blessing from Jehovah to His people.

- B. The Lord's promise in vs. 24 to bless and keep is an aspect of the core promise of God's covenant: I will never leave you or forsake you.

II. Promised Grace

- A. God's declaration in vs. 24 shows clearly that God's blessing upon us is gracious.

- B. We are reminded by the text that the blessing of God on us is undeserved.

III. Promised Peace

- A. God's covenant is a covenant of peace (Shalom). This means we have everlasting friendship with Jehovah.

- B. The blessing of this is that God puts His name on us (vs. 27).
