The 1611 Meaning Of "Study"

In the Oxford English Dictionary, the most exhaustive in print, there are no less than fifteen distinct meanings listed by dates of usage for "study." The very first meaning (out of fifteen different meanings) of the English word, "study," from about 1300 to 1769 A.D. is this:

"1.a. To apply the mind to the acquisition of learning, whether by means of books, observation, or experiment. †Const. in, on, upon (a book, a branch of learning). See also sense 1 d."

The meaning 1 d is as follows:

"d. To make a close study of (a subject), to 'bone' up (on, in), esp. in preparation for some display of knowledge (intr. use of sense 7 b). U.S. colloq."

The meaning of 7b is as follows:

"b. colloq. to study up: to study (a subject) in view of some special emergency, e.g. an examination; to 'get up'."

I maintain that this is the precise sense of "study" used by our King James translators in 1611 in this verse.
