Grace for the Religious

Phil. 3:4-11

Though I myself have reason for confidence in the flesh also. If anyone else thinks he has reason for confidence in the flesh, I have more: circumcised on the eighth day, of the people of Israel, of the tribe of Benjamin, a Hebrew of Hebrews; as to the law, a Pharisee;

as to zeal, a persecutor of the church; as to righteousness under the law, blameless.

But whatever gain I had,

I counted as loss for the sake of Christ. Indeed,

I count everything as loss because of the surpassing worth of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord.

For His sake I have suffered the loss of all things and count them as rubbish, in order that I may gain Christ and be found in Him, not having a righteousness of my own that comes from the law, but that which comes through faith in Christ, the righteousness from God

that depends on faith —

that I may know Him

and the power of His resurrection, and may share His sufferings, becoming like Him in His death, that by any means possible I may attain the resurrection from the dead.

What about -

- the "good" person?
- the "nice" guy?
- the "decent" family?

"Grace is lavish, undeserved, extravagant. We can't earn it, we can't contribute to it, we can't repay him for it, we can't take any credit for it.
