- **C. STRIVE IN THE HOLY SPIRIT TO GROW IN THIS DUAL SEPARATION** (Rom.8:13; Eph.4:25f,30f; 5:1ff; see 6:10f; Col.3:5f&12ff; Rom.7:14f; Gal.5:16f(19f&22f); the war for holiness; 1Pt.5:8f)
- **D. BE NOURISHED BY THE HOLY SPIRIT FOR THIS GROWTH** (Acts 2:42; see 2Tim.3:16(Gen.2:7) & 1Cor.12:13(Rom.6:3f); Jn.6:53f,63 (bread = set apart *to*; cup = set apart *from*) & Rom.8:26f & 1Cor.12:13f; see 1Tm.4:5)
- E. BE EXERCISED BY THE HOLY SPIRIT FOR THIS GROWTH (Rm13:14f; 5:3-5; Jms1:2f; Heb12:10-14)

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS FOR PRIVATE, FAMILY & SMALL GROUP FELLOWSHIP

Suggestions: Don't feel obliged to use every question or every part of every question. Go through and discuss those that are of greatest interest to you. Then consider going back and discussing those that may also be useful, including those that may have seemed a bit difficult. In all questions, keep the outline before to identify entries relevant to the question and to look up appropriate verses listed.

- 1. What most surprised, puzzled or impressed you from this sermon?
- 2. What was most helpful? Why? How will you apply it in your daily life?
- 3. What Scripture references were most helpful and why?
- 4. What are the primary doctrinal points of this passage? Do you believe these things?
- 5. What are the primary *practical* points? Do you do *these* things?
- 6. What is the basic idea in sanctification? Which of the examples given is most forceful to you? Why?
- 7. Why is "holy" connected most especially to the third Person of the Trinity, the Spirit?
- 8. What is false holiness? What is true unholiness? Do you see any of these things in your life? How should you change?
- 9. Are we holy by nature? Why not? How not?
- 10. Who is the only truly holy man? Why is this significant for us?
- 11. How is sanctification begin, continue and finish?
- 12. What is the relationship between justification and sanctification? Which comes first logically? Which of the illustrations do you find most helpful? Why?
- 13. How are justification and sanctification similar?
- 14. Why should you be holy? How does holiness give evidence of our adoption?
- 15. How must you begin sanctification? How must you continue it? How will you complete it?
- 16. What means does the Holy Spirit use to sanctify us?

FURTHER: Discuss the *Larger Catechism* (incl. references) & consider memorizing *Shorter Catechism* on "Sanctification".

Larger Catechism - Q. 75. What is sanctification? A. Sanctification is a work of God's grace, whereby they whom God hath before the foundation of the world chosen to be holy, are in time through the powerful operation of his Spirit, applying the death and resurrection of Christ unto them, renewed in their whole man after the image of God; having the seeds of repentance unto life, and all other saving graces, put into their hearts, and those graces so stirred up, increased, and strengthened, as that they more and more die unto sin and rise unto newness of life. Eph. 1:4; 1 Cor. 6:11; 2 Thess. 2:13; Rom. 6:4-6; Eph. 4:23-24; Acts 11:18; 1 John 3:9; Jude 1:20; Heb. 6:11-12; Eph. 3:16-19; Col. 1:10-11; Rom. 6:4, 6, 14; Gal. 5:24. **See also Q.76-78**

Shorter Catechism Q. **32** Q. 35. *What is sanctification?* A. Sanctification is the work of God's free grace, whereby we are renewed in the whole man after the image of God, and are enabled more and more to die unto sin, and live unto righteousness. 2 Thess. 2:13; Eph. 4:23-24; Rom. 6:4, 6; Rom. 8:1. *See also Q.35,36*
